Nitrogen (N) 18.0% - (Ammoniacal-N 0.2%), (Nitrate-N 0.5%), (Ureic-N 17.3%)

Potassium Oxide (K<sub>2</sub>O) 13.0% (as K 10.8%)

Slow Release Green R provides a balanced nutrient supply to encourage hardy turf with good colour but without excessive top growth. Fielder Slow Release Green R should be used as the first fertiliser application for all intensively managed fine turf prior to heavy nitrogen applications. Also ideal for season-long use on areas of less stress, e.g. fairways & parks.

Manufactured to a high standard for Fielder by a leading producer of plant feeds, Slow Release Green R will encourage a quick & lasting green-up of Golf greens and fairways, bowling greens, tennis courts, sportsfields, parks & other amenity and landscaped areas.

### RATES OF USE:

Fine turf - (e.g. - golf greens, tennis courts etc.) - apply 2 litres per 500 sq. metres (1/2 gallon per 600 sq. yards), in a minimum of 20 litres (4 1/2 gallons) of water.

For larger areas - (e.g. - sportsfields, racecourses, golf fairways, amenity areas etc.) - apply 40 litres per ha. (3 1/2 galls / acre) in a minimum 350 litres (30 gallons) of water.

### TIMING:

For best results apply when turf is actively growing. Repeat applications every four to six weeks as required.

### APPLICATION:

Apply with conventional handheld, pedestrian controlled, or tractor mounted sprayers, using fan jets fitted with 30 mesh nozzles. Apply as a medium or coarse spray.

### MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

Half-fill spray tank with water. Add in the liquid fertiliser and make up to the required volume with water. Secure lid and agitate thoroughly. It is possible to include selective weedkillers; for more information on compatibility, consult manufacturer.

### PRECAUTIONS:

Avoid spraying during high temperatures or when grass is under stress. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contact with skin or eyes, wash exposed area of skin with water. Avoid spillage onto clothing, paths or hard surfaces as staining may occur. Protect from frost.
